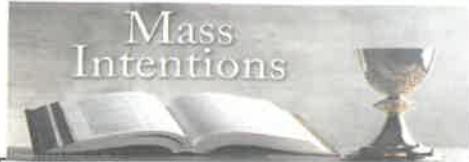

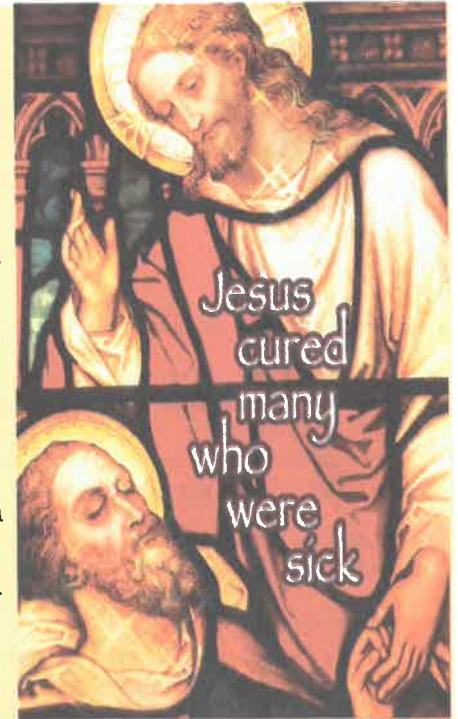

MT. OLIVET CEMETERY DECORATING RULES

****If you currently have ANY statues in Mt. Olivet, please remove them by April 30th. Any remaining statues will be removed by cemetery staff ****

1. **NO ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS ON THE GROUND.** Your artificial flowers must be in a ground vase. Please replace artificial arrangements as they become weathered or faded. Flower pots are not allowed. They will be removed.
2. **NO statues, figurines, benches, mementos, toys, metal signs, trinkets, balloons, pin wheels, etc.,** are allowed in any part of the cemetery and will be removed.
3. **NO ROSEBUSHES, SHRUBS, EVERGREENS OR BUSHES** of any kind are allowed and will be removed.
4. **NO DECORATIVE FENCES, GLASS CONTAINERS, STONES, WOODCHIPS OR BORDERS OF ANY KIND** ARE ALLOWED IN ANY SECTION AND WILL BE REMOVED.
5. **PLANTED FLOWERS:**
 1. Families with an **UPRIGHT or SLANT MONUMENT:** Flowers can be planted no more than 10 inches in front of the stone. No planting on the side of any stone or monument. If your planted flowers become unsightly, they will be cut down.
 2. Families with a **FLUSH LAWN LEVEL MARKER:** Planting is not allowed in these areas. Fresh or artificial flowers are allowed only in a ground vase behind the stone. Any planted flowers will be removed.
6. Solar lights are **not permitted** on the ground.
7. Wreath and blankets are permitted on the grave sites during the winter season.
8. **SHEPHERD HOOKS:**
 - Only 1 shepherd hook is allowed per grave. Shepherd hooks must be placed **BEHIND** your stone for flush markers. Improper placement will result in removal.

The cemetery is not responsible for **any articles** placed on lots, **stone damage** or **vandalism of any kind.** Lot owners should always check their stone at the time of placement for damages.

While we recognize the need to decorate your loved ones graves, we hope you understand that in order to maintain the cemetery's appearance, all rules must be enforced. In doing so we are able to make the grounds a comfortable, peaceful place for those buried here as well as those who visit.
