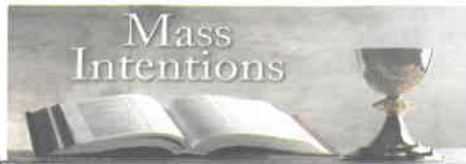

(Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21).

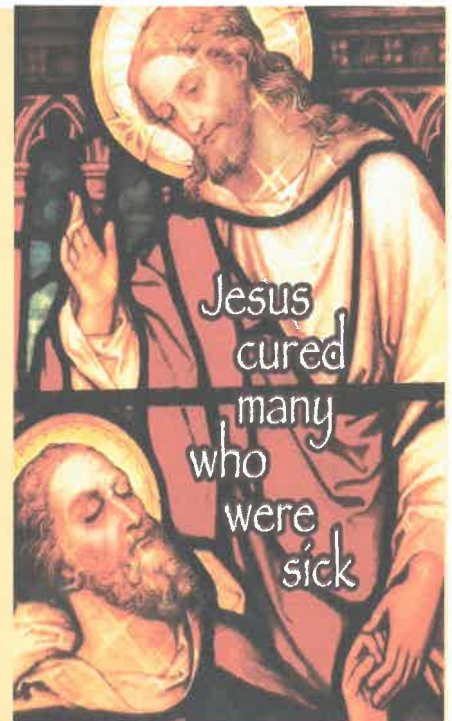

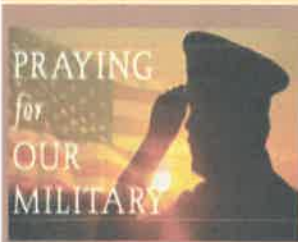

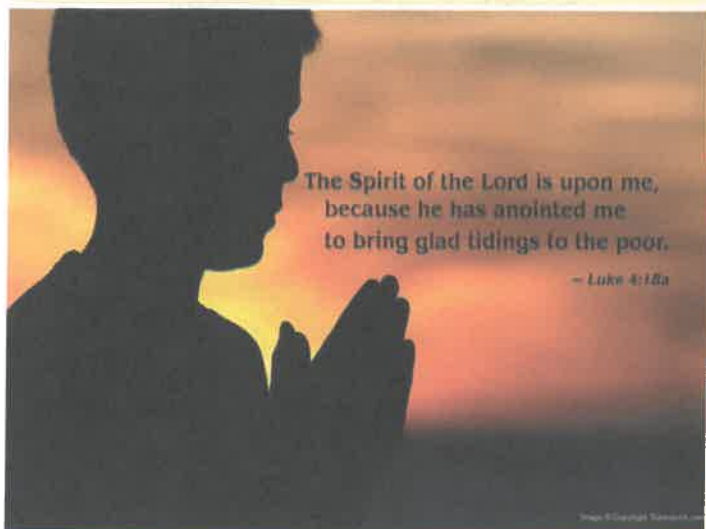
