

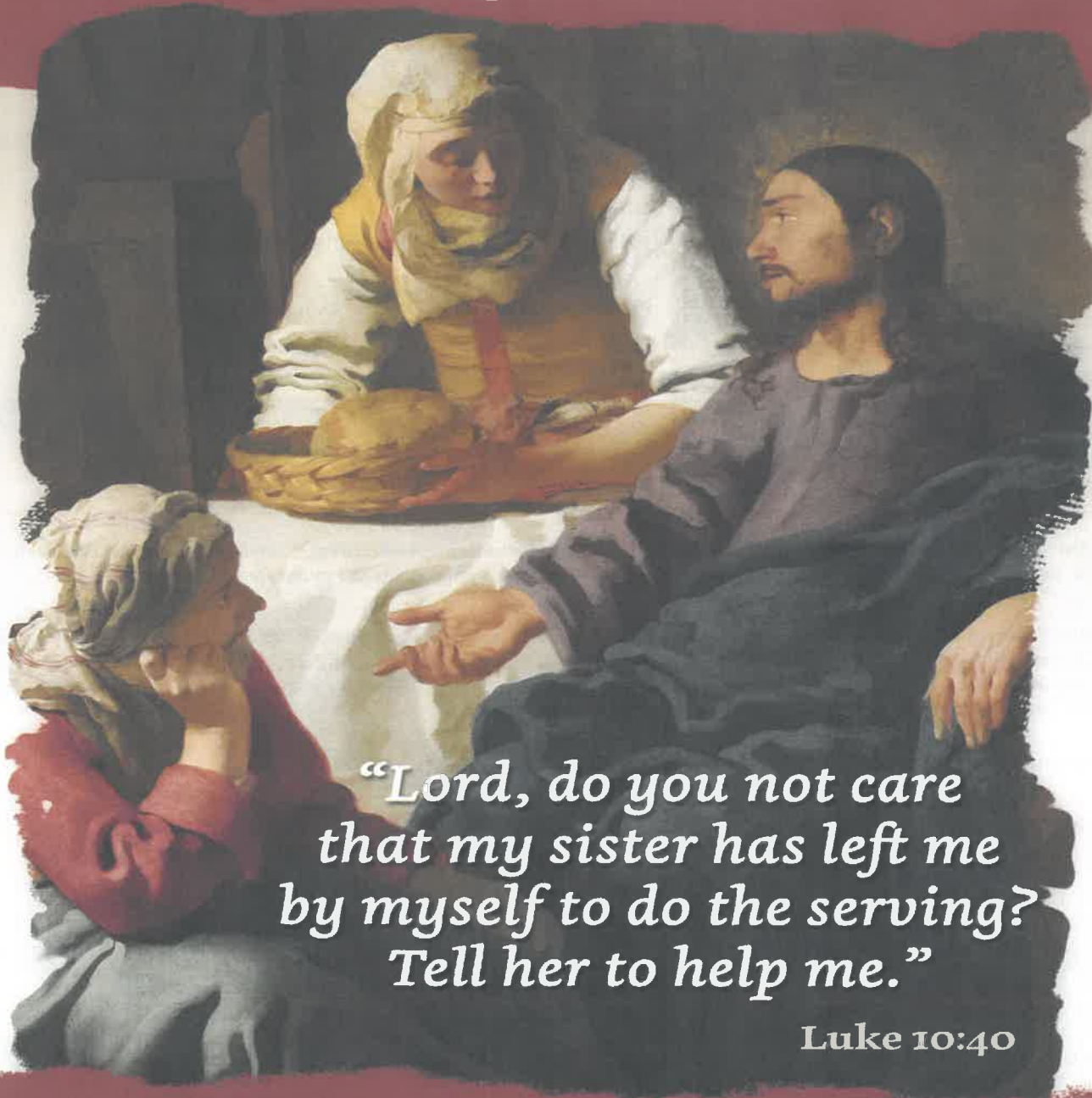

Sacraments

BAPTISM Parents having their First Child baptized must complete a baptismal preparation class. Currently we are only scheduling private Baptisms on Saturdays and Sunday. Please contact the Parish Office to make arrangements and to discuss available dates.

MARRIAGE Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. Marriage preparation classes are required to be completed before the Sacrament of Marriage can be celebrated. A person or their family must be registered parishioners for a minimum of 6 months before contacting us about a wedding date. This is done to ensure that adequate time is allowed for preparation. We do not have weddings on Sundays. Please contact the Parish Office before making wedding arrangements.

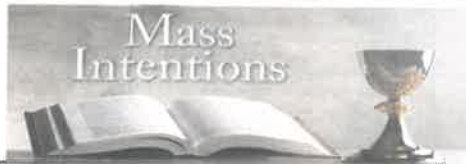

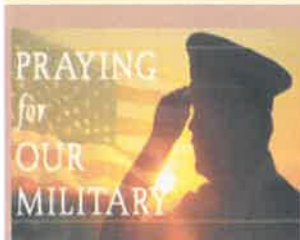
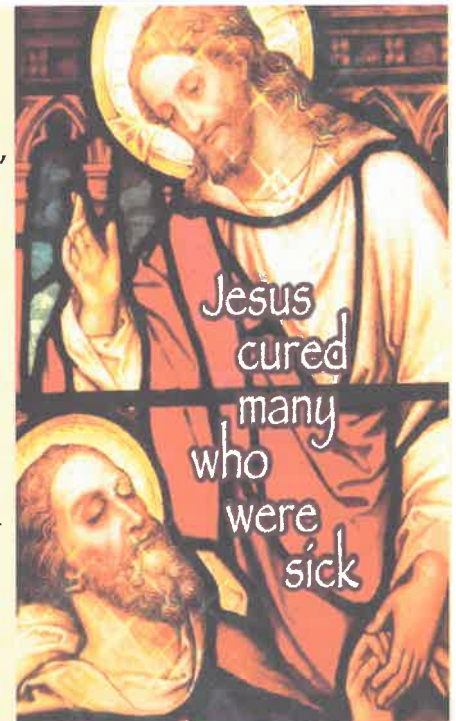
***St. Rose:* We will soon start our summer schedule. There will not be Adoration/Confession from June 2nd- Sept. 1st on Thursday evenings.**

***St. Patrick:* We will not have Adoration or Confession during the month of June.**

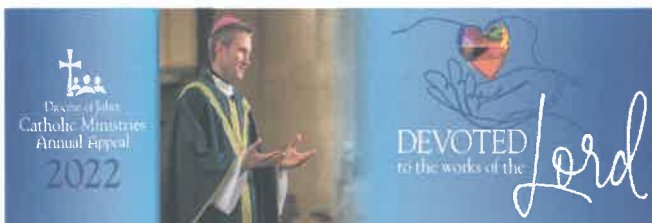

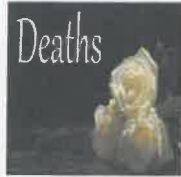
