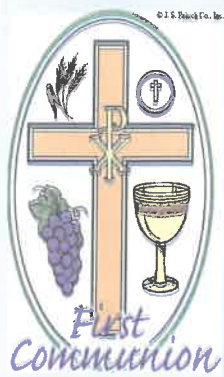
Baby Shower: As has been our very special project over the last several years, we will again sponsor a Baby Shower throughout the **month of May** to benefit the Living Alternatives
