ANOINTING OF THE SICK Please call our emergency line to schedule a time with Father.

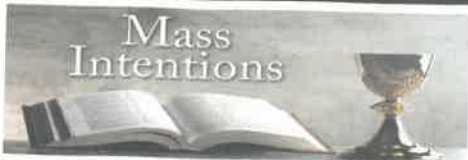

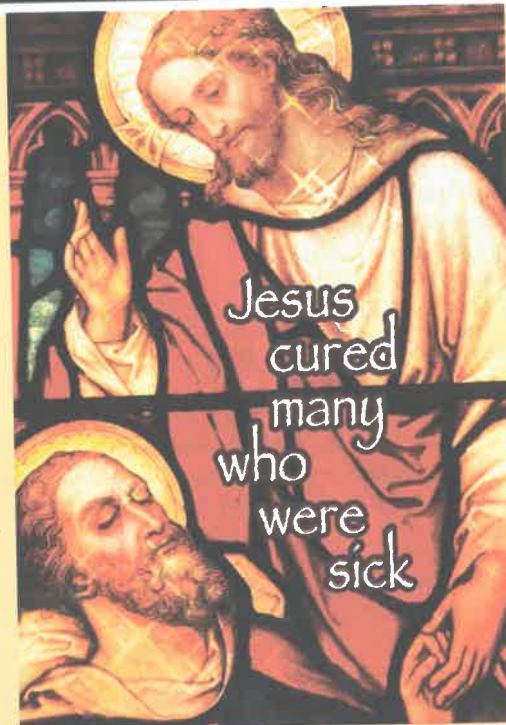

SAVE THE PARENTAL NOTICE OF ABORTION LAW!

State lawmakers are meeting on October 19 and they are considering repealing the Parental Notice of Abortion Act. We must act to prevent this!

72% of all Illinois voters agree that parents or an adult guardian should be informed if their child is seeking an abortion, yet the Illinois General Assembly continues to threaten the repeal of Illinois' Parental Notice of Abortion law.

Our St. Rose Council of Catholic Women will again participate in the diocesan wide Box of Joy program. This outreach provides a shoebox of small gifts

and treats to the very poor children in Central America. In most cases this box will be the only Christmas gifts these children will receive.

The drive begins on the weekend of **October 9-10** with shoeboxes available at the church entrances. (Or feel free to use your own cardboard or plastic shoebox to fill.) When choosing gifts, stick to a particular age group for a boy or girl and keep in mind these children generally do not speak English and live in a warm climate. A list of gift ideas is included in each box as well as on the display board. Include your kids or grands in your shopping adventure— they will know what items their age group would enjoy. Personalize your box by wrapping a few of the gifts in colored paper, including a personal greeting or ornament, or even a family photo, etc. Have fun with it!


All boxes need to be returned by **Sunday, October 31st** to allow time for delivery to the central collection site for bulk packaging and shipping. **\$9.00** in cash or check made out to Cross Catholic Outreach enclosed in an envelope should be placed in the box on top of your gifts. If you are unable to shop and wish to participate in this program, you may simply make a donation of any amount. If you need a box or are unable to return your box back to the church, please call Pat @ 815-476-1699 or Laura @ 630-302-2681. This will be our fifth year of participation in this project and St. Rose has become known as the "Box of Joy Parish", leading the deanery in number of boxes collected and second in the entire Joliet Diocese. Dear Friends,

Many of you know that I have a missionary heart. I spent five years of my priesthood living and working in Central America in the country of El Salvador. I loved it.

But you don't have to travel to another country to be a missionary. You can do so here, at home, by looking for opportunities to put your faith into action.

One of those opportunities is World Mission Sunday, which we celebrate this year on October 24. The second collection taken up on that weekend serves as a worldwide effort to provide for the strengthening of more than 1,000 local churches in Asia and Africa, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe. Through the work of these churches and their witness to Christ, the poor receive practical help and experience God's Love, mercy and peace.

Pope Francis has taken a verse from the Act of the Apostles as the theme for this year's World Mission Sunday: "We cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard." (Acts 4:20) The Holy Father encourages us to reach beyond our usual limits – both physical and spiritual – to spread the love of Christ.

"By its very nature, the life of faith calls for a growing openness to embracing everyone, everywhere," Pope Francis writes in his message for World Mission Sunday.

Let us all become missionaries by strengthening the Church abroad through a donation to the second collection on the weekend of October 23-24.
