



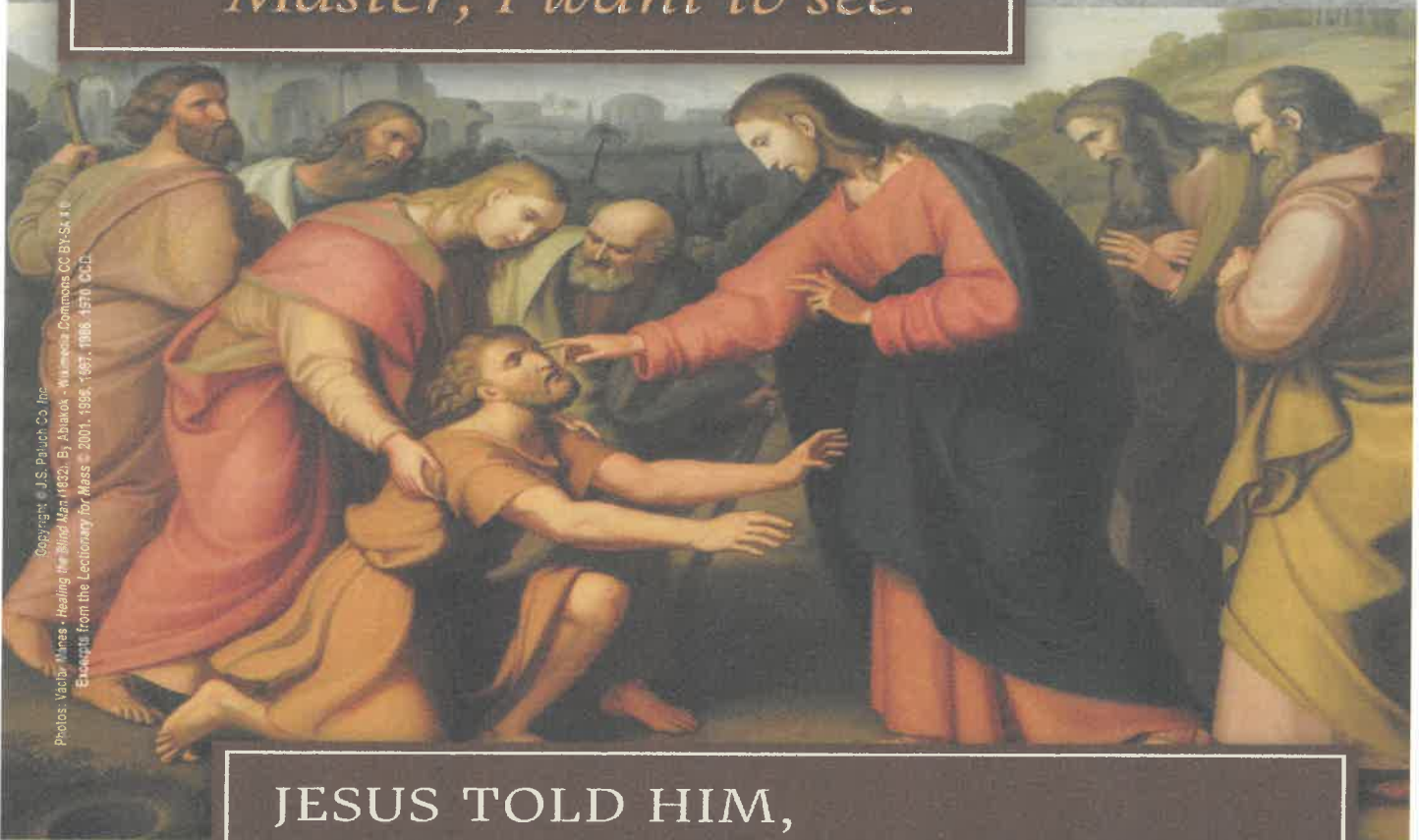

ANOINTING OF THE SICK Please call our emergency line to schedule a time with Father.

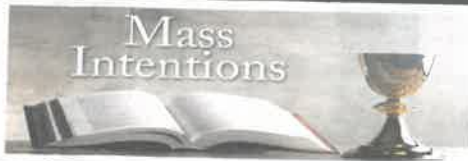
